Dear NMVTIS Reporting Entities:

The U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) oversees the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS), with the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA) serving as the system operator. BJA appreciates the actions of required reporting entities across the nation to register with one of the approved Third Party Data Consolidators that provide services to NMVTIS. This action is necessary to enable reporting entities, as required by federal statute, to report junk and salvage (including total loss) automobiles to NMVTIS.

BJA is currently assessing entities that have registered to report to NMVTIS but have not reported any junk and salvage automobiles. All required reporting entities are encouraged to comply with the reporting requirements that are outlined on the NMVTIS Program page at https://vehiclehistory.bja.ojp.gov/nmytis_auto. For entities that fail to come into compliance, BJA will, as appropriate, initiate civil actions that may lead to penalties.
